Quicken: Discuss Quicken problems, solutions and tips—a forum for Quicken users to help one another.

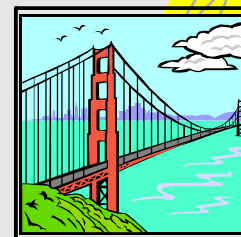
Wireless: Learn the in’s and out’s of wireless networking and the tricks to compute securely.
